Re: Notice of State APSCURF Elections

The election of State APSCURF officers will be conducted in the spring of 2010. The offices to be filled at this election are President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Delegate and Alternate Delegate. Any eligible member of APSCURF who is interested in running for an office should identify the office being sought and submit his/her resume of qualifications for office by February 12, 2010. The resume should be no more than 250 words in length and mailed to Don Mayer C/O Monica Troutman, PO Box 11995, Harrisburg, PA 17108.

According to the bylaws, the people in the following positions are ineligible to succeed themselves: President and Treasurer.

The Nominations and Elections Committee will meet on or before March 1, 2010 to develop the slate of officers to stand for election. The nominated individuals will have their resumes posted on the APSCURF webpage and sent to all electors. Ballots will be sent to Electors by March 7, 2010 and are to be returned to the APSCURF Office no later than April 7, 2010. The Nominations Committee would appreciate responses from those intending to run for any of the offices as soon as possible.

Please circulate widely among your local APSCURF membership that the election will be held in spring 2010 and the Nominations Committee is now receiving nominations.
