**BENEFIT ALERT—SHINGLES VACCINE BY NANCY**

The shingles vaccine came on the market for adults a couple of years back. Highmark was requested to provide for each benefit plan whether or not the vaccine would be considered eligible under those plans. That information still stands except for those ANNUITANTS who are 65 and over and are covered under the Medicare Complement plan. Highmark has indicated that the policy may have been misinterpreted in 2008 and APSCUF is in discussions with Highmark concerning the coverage. So if you and/or your spouse is contemplating with your doctor about obtaining the shingles



vaccine, please be aware that at this time, Highmark is denying that service as being ineligible. Once the final decision is made, information will be communicated via the APSCURF web page and/or email. Though, according to Highmark, they will continue to reimburse the prescriptions used to treat the outbreak of shingles.
