IUP Faculty Approves 'No Confidence' Vote in University President Tony Atwater

With over 100 faculty in attendance, including 35 department chairs who were invited to attend, IUP's Representative Council has elected to conduct a vote of no confidence in IUP President Tony Atwater.

Three votes were taken, the first to authorize the vote of no confidence in the president. The second vote was of the members of Representative Council who voted unanimously no confidence in the president. The third vote was of the members of the Council of Chairs who also voted unanimously no confidence in the president.

The vote is scheduled for December 14-16 with the result being formally presented to the IUP Council of Trustees at their December 17th meeting.
